Information Update

Jasper Intergovernmental Forum, June 2018

The Municipality of Jasper and the Parks Canada Agency in Jasper National Park are committed to a positive, mutually beneficial relationship based on shared goals and interests. To this end, representatives from the two organizations as well as mayor and council meet three to four times per year to discuss and advance topics of mutual interest. The June 19, 2018 Intergovernmental Forum highlights include:

Wildfire Information Session

- Parks Canada and the Municipality of Jasper have agreed to co-host a public information session on wildfire preparedness and are working on scheduling and logistics. More information will be provided once a date is set for the event.

Mobile Home Replacement in the Event of a Wildfire

- Parks Canada is reviewing the Area Redevelopment Plan for the Jasper Mobile Home District and will work with the Municipality of Jasper to develop an update or addendum regarding the replacement of mobile homes in the trailer court in the event of a wildfire.

Recreational Marijuana

- The Cannabis Working Group, which includes representatives from Parks Canada and the Municipality of Jasper, presented a report and community survey results at the June 26 Council Committee of the Whole meeting. Visit the municipal website for details at jasper-alberta.com/cannabis.

Aspen Gardens

- Parks Canada issued a development permit for 21 two-bedroom units to be built on the current Aspen Gardens leasehold. Once constructed, the units will be available for purchase. A building permit has not yet been issued.

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
