

Some discussion took place on the SEED building which was supposed to be a stand-alone building. Mrs. Cooper advised that the building is net zero where we produce energy- in summer it will produce energy, paying back to the grid, and in winter will use power. Some councillors felt there has been a mis-understanding about the status of the power issue surrounding the SEED building right from the start. Mayor Ireland recalled that, during a Skype chat, the architect had said that the building didn't have to be connected to anything. He also indicated that the Municipality's support is through the Environmental Stewardship reserve fund, for a total of \$10,000 (\$5,000 from Parks Canada and \$5,000 from the Municipality. It was supposed to be free in the first place, but now a cost has materialized out of nowhere. Mrs. Cooper advised that fundraising issues at the other end are making costs jump up. The SEED building is expected to arrive in Jasper in the near future.

Bylaw Summary Council received, for information purposes, a summary of bylaws current in force in the Municipality and those in their various stages of readings.

Bylaw #158 ATCO Franchise Agreement #114/13 MOTION by Councillor Skehill – BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council give third and final reading to Bylaw #158, being a bylaw of the Municipality of Jasper in the Province of Alberta to authorize the Mayor and CAO to enter into an agreement granting ATCO Electric the right to provide distribution access services within the Town of Jasper. Parks' certification has been received.
