## Mobile Home Replacement Following a Wildfire

The Municipality of Jasper and Parks Canada have formally agreed that in the event of an involuntary removal of a mobile home – due to a wildfire, for example – a mobile home may be replaced with a new mobile home.

A number of residents had raised concerns with the *Area Redevelopment Plan for the Jasper Mobile Home District* (2004) (the Plan), which states that new installation of traditional mobile homes would not be permitted. The Plan now has an addendum to address this concern. As insurance typically provides for 'like for like' replacement, this change should allow homeowners to replace their homes within the limits of their insurance policies.

Both Parks Canada and the Municipality of Jasper recognize that this addendum to the Plan is in the community's best interest and presents a more fair and practical process for homeowners.

The Municipality of Jasper and the Parks Canada Agency in Jasper National Park are committed to a positive, mutually beneficial relationship based on shared goals and interests.
